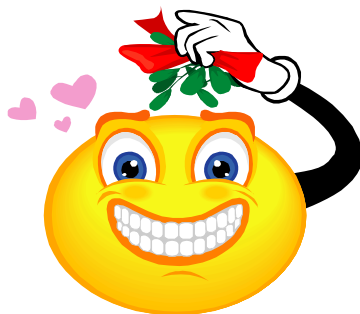
****SCHOOL RESUMES January 7, 2008.*
